
Shoreline Cleanups- Locations

- 2,242 cigarette butts
- 2,221 food wrappers
- 1,820 non-descript plastic film
- 1,580 plastic bottle caps


- 1,036 non-descript foam
- 972 rope pieces < 3ft
- 783 net pieces
- 586 balloons/strings
- 444 straws/stirrers

Shoreline Cleanups- Fishing Gear






- 972 rope pieces < 3ft



Outer Cape Cleanup- Dates & Locations



Part I: September 30, 2022

Day 1: Coast Guard → LeCount Hollow

Part II: October 15-17, 2022

Day 2: LeCount Hollow → Ballston

Day 3: Ballston → High Head

Day 4: High Head → Race Point

- 44 volunteers over 4 days
- About 30 miles of coastline
- 14,589 pieces of debris removed





Outer Cape Cleanup- Top 5: Day by day



Day 1: Coast Guard → LeCount Hollow

- 327 non-descript rigid plastic
- 202 rope pieces < 3 ft
- 227 non-descript plastic film
- 172 food wrappers
- 160 balloons/strings

Day 2: LeCount Hollow → Ballston

- 517 non-descript rigid plastic
- 368 non-descript plastic film
- 292 food wrappers
- 235 balloons/strings
- 227 plastic bottle caps


Day 3: Ballston → High Head

- 151 balloons/strings
- 138 non-descript rigid plastic
- 135 foam cup pieces
- 137 food wrappers
- 126 rope pieces < 3 ft

Day 4: High Head → Race Point

- 1059 non-descript foam
- 910 foam cup pieces
- 430 non-descript rigid plastic
- 399 rope pieces < 3 ft
- 221 non-descript plastic film

Top 10 Debris

- 1,831 non-descript foam
- 1,412 non-descript rigid plastic
- 1,406 foam cup pieces
- 881 rope pieces < 3 ft
- 816 non-descript plastic film

- 785 food wrappers
- 745 balloons/strings
- 637 plastic bottle caps
- 368 rope knots
- 262 non-descript metal




















2022 Yearly Totals

- 3,727 non-descript rigid plastic
- 2,702 food wrappers
- 2,636 non-descript plastic film
- 2,371 cigarette butts
- 2,217 plastic bottle caps
- 2,786 non-descript foam
- 1,853 rope pieces < 3 ft
- 1,626 foam cup pieces
- 1,331 balloons/strings
- 878 net pieces








Lobster Trap ID Tags



- 3,985 tags collected and recorded (as of August 2022)
 - o 2,805 logged from Nova Scotia
 - o 1,179 logged from Cape Cod
